



11. Ensures a safe working environment by assisting with the supervision of students in the application of safe processes and procedures for working in a kitchen.
12. Performs other assigned comparable duties which are within the scope of knowledge, skills and ability required by this position.

**REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, ABILITY AND SKILLS:**

1. Successful completion of Grade 10 plus the Professional Cook 1 Certificate of Qualification or the equivalent training and experience.
2. One (1) year of recent relevant experience.
3. Basic knowledge of cleaning materials, methods and equipment used in a cafeteria/kitchen. Experience in commercial cooking establishments is desirable.
4. Ability to operate a cash register.
5. Ability to communicate and function effectively and harmoniously in a student/teaching environment.
6. Sufficient physical strength, health and coordination to perform a variety of moderately heavy physical and manual tasks.
